


The delicious food served will be Glatt Kosher for Pessach under the supervision of the trusted Gibraltar Kashrut Authority offering the highest standards of Kashrut.


SANTA CLARA

Santa Clara Country Hotel is set on a hill overlooking the Santa Clara lake. This hotel is idyllic and in perfect harmony with nature and the unspoiled natural environment. The tranquility will take you back in time and will exceed your expectations.

Santa Clara dam was built by the Estado Novo and completed in 1969, it covers about 2 thousand hectares, taking advantage of the Mira River's waters. A magnificent basin of water that shelters various species of fish, for those who like fishing. This immense water reservoir provides irrigation for the surrounding lands planted with cork, oaks and holms. The surrounding country is home to a wide variety of birds and wildlife, literally on our doorstep and at night, with no light pollution, the stars are a sight to behold. This stunning location is an hour and fifteen minutes away from Faro International Airport and two hours from Lisbon International Airport.


Pixels & Prints: The Photography Journey
